- Motion to approve Treasurer Report by Greg Wiemann and seconded by Keven Stelzel. Motion passed

Membership

- A motion was made to nominate Cody Stelzel as an honorary member by Keven Stelzel and seconded by Randy Crawford. Motion passed
- The Secretary Treasurer reported on membership.
- We have seven new members since the December semi-annual meeting.
- Total membership stands at 46; however, not all are active based on a two-year review of dues and volunteer hours.
- The board will contact and suspend membership for anyone that is clearly inactive. This is not equivalent to expulsion and is only intended for a member that cannot fully engage in the club at this time. Those members are welcome back when they can participate.

Committee Reports

- Sports Show
 - Al Jeske reported on the shoot. Another great event.
 - Approximately 230 shooters.
 - We have been invited back to run the shoot again next year.
 - Targets are a big expense and we need replacements.
 - We continue to look for sponsors.
 - Darren Rose provided an update on video for the shoot. He recommended moving from Facebook to YouTube for better functions and exposure.
- Sports Show Warmup

- Al Jeske discussed the possibility of hosting on Friday and Sunday to work around the youth league and focusing on the 2D format.
- After considerable discussion, it was decided to hold a one-day shoot in conjunction with the youth league on Saturday, February 13th. The format will include both 2D and spot targets.
- Motion to approve by Steve Wieting and seconded by Greg Wiemann. Motion passed.
- Carp Shoot
 - Cancelled for 2026.
- KM
 - We averaged 120 archers participating per shoot in the indoor winter season.
 - West Town Archers will be hosting Wale Tales Archery as the winners of the bowhunter competition. The Bowhunter Banquet will be held on September 18th at West Town.
 - Kenosha has proposed replacing the summer KM events with a 3D league. Scoring would be a simplified 10-8-5-0 and omit 12 or 14.
 - The Vegas shoot was lightly attended. It will be replaced with a one-day shoot that will function as a scholarship fundraiser.
 - Keven Stelzel discussed the WTA club hosting a summer KM at another club's facilities. There was concern over the struggle to get volunteers, and the prospect that this would effectively be a fundraiser for another club.
- Pheasant Hunt
 - Barry Geary and Al Jeske are the current committee members. Adding Rob Schaffhauser to the committee.
 - Nothing to report
- Summer Picnic/Corn Roast
 - Mary & Fred Schaffhauser volunteered to host again this year.
 - Plan for Richfield Days, August 22nd, 2026
 - Mary will purchase the supplies and ask for volunteers to cook. Volunteer list pending.
- Monthly Socials
 - We need to put together dates for the club social calendar and published on the shop website.
 - It was noted that not all socials require a theme. We merely need a volunteer to coordinate.

Elections

- Secretary/Treasurer two-year term
- Keven Stelzel nominated Lori Zyduck. Nomination declined.
- Steve Wieting nominated Keven Stelzel. Seconded by Barry Geary. Nomination accepted.
- Motion to elect Keven Stelzel by Chris Becker and seconded by Lori Zyduck. Keven Stelzel was unanimously elected to Secretary/Treasurer.

Due Structures

- No changes to membership dues for 2026-27
- Motion to approve the dues structure by Keven Stelzel and seconded by Dan Schuler. Motion pass.

Old Business

- Second vote and final approval of amendment to Club Constitution to adjust election timing of Board members. Modify Article 4, Section 4 of the bylaws to stagger elections of President and Vice President from Secretary/Treasurer:

ARTICLE 4 – BOARD

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Section 4 - Election and Terms of Office

The persons receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected Board Members based on plurality therefore a majority vote shall not be necessary. These individuals shall serve a two (2) year term of office commencing July 1st of the election year and shall serve for two (2) years. *Elections for President and Vice President will occur on odd number years, and election for Secretary/Treasurer will occur on even number years.*

- Motion to approve constitutional amendment by Keven Stelzel and seconded by Bill Klug. Motion passed.

New Business

- Steve Wieting motioned the club to contribute \$1,000 towards a new Bullmastiff club mascot to be cared for by Bill Klug.

- After discussion, Steve Wieting motioned the club to match up to \$750 in donations towards a new Bullmastiff club mascot to be cared for by Bill Klug. Seconded by Zach Jeske. Motion passed.

- December 18th, 2026. Semi-annual meeting and Christmas party.
